### Divine Mercy Sunday Celebrations

Divine Mercy Sunday will have a special liturgy at Saint Patrick Church on April 8th. Father Alphonse Van Guilder will preside. The schedule is: Confessions from 1:30 to 2:45; the Solemn Blessing of the Divine Mercy Image at 2:45; celebration of the Eucharist at 3:00 and the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy at 4:00. A first-class relic of Saint Faustina will be present at the devotion.

### Annual Ministry Appeal (AMA)

Father Victor has already requested that the parish strongly and devotedly support the bishop in his work. There are a group of ministries which are coordinated by Bishop Garcia and his office. 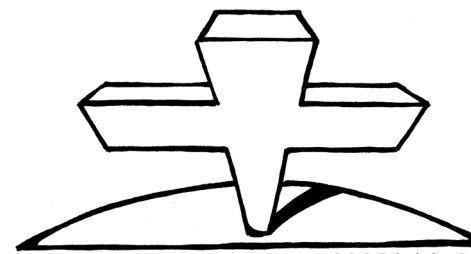
