On account of the many blessings conferred there, the celebration of a liturgical feast was granted for August 2nd, which marks the anniversary of the dedication of this chapel.

A plenary indulgence may be gained on the previous weekend or the following weekend by visiting any church. Besides the prayers for the visit, prayers for the Holy Father, a firm intention not to sin and the reception of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist are required.

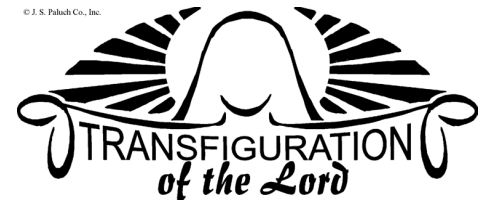
