No Dispensation for Valentine's Day

The Bishops are insisting on Fast and Abstinence for Wednesday. Celebrate Valentine's on Tuesday with Mardi Gras.

Lent Begins

Wednesday, February 14th, is Ash Wednesday. The period of Lent is a special preparation for the Solemnity of the Lord's Resurrection (Easter). Ashes will be distributed DURING three Masses and at a special service for the students of our Faith Formation program.

Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday is a day of fast AND abstinence. The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Abstinence is required of all Catholics over the age of 14 (no upper limit). This means that no meat or meat products (soups, gravies, consommés, etc.) are to be eaten on Ash Wednesday or the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is required of all Catholics age 18 to 59 on Ash Wednesday. This means that only one full meal is allowed, with two smaller meals as needed (no solid food between meals). These regulations are considered to be a serious obligation for all Catholics. However, those who are ill, pregnant, on medication or special diets for health concerns or those who must work at extremely physical jobs may be exempt from these regulations.

Fish Fry at Saint Patrick Parish

The Italian Catholic Federation (ICF) at St. Patrick's Church in Arroyo Grande will be hosting Fish Fries on five Fridays during Lent. Mark Your calendar and join us for a delicious fish & chips and coleslaw dinner. Fish fries will be held on the following Fridays: February 16th, February 23rd, March 2nd, March 9th and March 23rd from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. in St. Patrick's Church Hall, 501 Fair Oaks Avenue, Arroyo Grande. Prices range from \$8 for a 1-piece fish dinner to \$14 for a 4-piece fish dinner. Take-outs will be available. 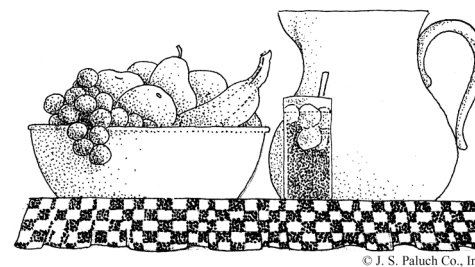
