A NEW Tax Reducing Opportunity at Year End

The IRS has offered a new approach to the required minimum distribution from IRAs for those who are 70-1/2 or older. An individual may now rollover all or part of the minimum required distribution to a charitable organization. The person pays NO tax on the charitable rollover distribution. 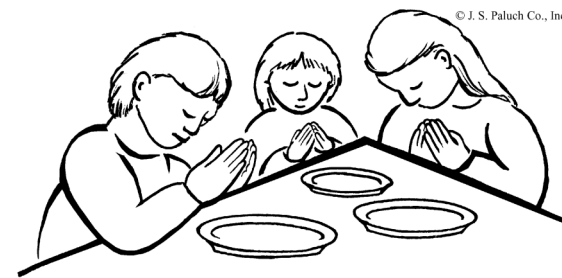
