COLUMBIA MAGAZINE

We are not alone.

This month's issue features the 136th Supreme Convention held in Baltimore, Maryland from August 7 to 9. Page after page provides some insights into Knights at home and abroad as we work for our Families, Parishes and Communities. Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson remarked: "We must step up now to bring younger men into the Order. We must reach out to where they are – not to where we think they should be." Throughout the issue are inspiring examples that "in today's world there are men who put their faith into action – men who bring value to our communities and hope to our nations." Our Council is part of this.

The new theme of the Order "Faith in Action" is meant to encourage councils (us) to engage in new activities to promote faith, family, life and community as our Order grows. The statistics are most impressive: worldwide membership totals 1,967,585 men in 15,900 councils.

Faith in Action translated into volunteer hours from California members totaling 3,200,000 and the total Order-wide is 75,600,000, a half-million more than the previous year.

Knights give as well as do. As of last August, Knights donated \$185 million compared to last year's \$177 million. Only second behind Texas (\$9.8 million), California Knights contributed \$7.4 million to fund our many programs.
